NEP 2020 re-imagines education at various levels

At School Level

New Education policy has introduced 5 + 3 + 3 + 4 instead of 10 + 2 + 3 system which emphasizes on early child hood education at the age of 3. It is stated in NEP 2020 that more investment will be there for Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE) so that all young children especially from weak socio economical section of society will have access to education and will enjoy healthy mental development.

- ECCE will basically include play way and activity based learning so as to inculcate social aspects, good behaviour, awareness towards cleanliness, team spirit and good communication skills, language and numerical literacy.
- School Education should emphasize on holistic and integrated personality of student and students should enjoy learning. Learning should be experiential, inspire for critical thinking, inculcate art education and culture so that children should imbibe Indian traditions and ethos.
- Sports related activities at early age will help in keeping fitness as lifelong attitude and will inculcate habit of self-discipline, teamwork and responsible citizen.
- Student should have flexibility to choose subjects of their choice from various streams including physical education, art and craft and vocational skills at secondary level. There will be no separation of streams such as science, arts, vocational education etc. The children at early age will be exposed to digital literacy, coding artificial intelligence, ethical, moral values, human and constitutional values. It will help students to plan their own path of study and life.
- Every student has some inbuilt qualities. These inner talents must be recognized and should further be nurtured. It is stated in NEP that children with special talent in any area should be helped to excel in that area beyond the curriculum.
- Teacher will be empowered so as to empower the children future of our nation. Teachers will be given all opportunities to learn new innovations in their profession.

At Higher Education level

Role of higher education is very important in reshaping the youth of our nation who are responsible for building up a democratic, socially aware, human value based, traditionally enriched and economically stronger nation. The following initiatives are in NEP2020 to enhance education Higher Education level

- Higher education will now be multidisciplinary. Now
 education system will include multidisciplinary
 universities and colleges. There will be more Higher
 Education institutes. HEI will offer medium of
 instruction for programme in local/Indian languages.
 This will help in developing holistic personality of
 student.
- Professional and vocational education will be integrated in higher education system. This will be for all streams and all HEIs and will result in merging all institutes in one ecosystem of education.
- More initiatives for student and faculty autonomy.
 HIEs will be administered by independent boards having academic and administrative economy.
- Curriculum, teaching pedagogy, assessments, student support system will be modified to full fill needs and experiences for students.
- To promote research initiatives and funding for researches National Research foundation will be established.
- To promote public education, education for unprivileged section of society online and open distance learning will be promoted to large extent. All learning material will be available for students with disabilities.
- Model Public Universities called MERUs (Multidisciplinary Education and Research Universities) will be set up for holistic and

- multidisciplinary education and will provide highest global standards for high quality education.
- Number of initiatives will be taken to improve student's support system and learning environment. To promote creativity among students, teachers will have full autonomy to innovate regarding matters of curriculum, teaching pedagogies, assessment etc. so as to improve the quality of education and students learning environment.
- More emphasis will be on internationalization of education. Students from India will be assisted with facilities to carry out researches at abroad and from foreign countries to India. An international student office will be set up at each HEIs to facilitate foreign students in all aspects related to their study in India.
- Education should lift up all individuals including people from underprivileged section of society. NEP ensures equitable quality education to all students fulfilling (Socio Economically Disadvantaged Groups (SEDGs)
- As teacher education programmes play an important role in shaping the future of school teachers. HEIs offering teacher education courses must ensure to provide quality education.
- To `improve the status of vocational education NEP 2020 has integrated vocational education in mainstream education in all HEIs in phased manner. According to policy at least 50% of students at both school and higher education will have exposure to vocational education by 2025.
- In present regulatory system of education power is concentrated with few bodies and there is conflict of interest among these bodies. So to overcome these problems Higher Education Commission of India will be set up. It will act as regulatory body and there will be four verticals of this body. Four verticals will perform the function of regulation, accreditation, funding, and academic standard setting of Higher Eduction institutes.
- There will be different mechanism and efforts to stop commercialization of Education.

Other Areas

Professional Education — A good professional must have some characteristics. He must possess education in ethics and must know the importance of public purpose, education in the discipline and education for practice. To achieve these characteristics he must have critical thinking, interdisciplinary thinking, must be able to debate and discuss on relevant topic, must have inclination towards research, must be innovative. For this professional education should be integrated in all higher education institutions. Stand-alone institution in specific discipline like agriculture university, legal universities, health science universities, technical universities shall become multidisciplinary institutions offering holistic and multidisciplinary education.

Adult Education and Life Long Learning

In any community if members are illiterate they suffer in life. They cannot carry out financial transactions, they are not able to decide whether price paid for purchase of goods is reasonable or not, they are not able to fill form regarding application of jobs, loans etc. They cannot understand public circular and articles in newspapers etc., the cannot comprehend safety rules in roads, are not aware of citizens basic rights and duties .They are not familiar with technology and cannot make us of e-mails for communication. To promote adult education NCERT will prepare a national

education framework for adult education which will basically focus on literacy, numeracy, basic education, vocational education and many more.
